



**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE ANADROM FISHING STRETCH (YELLOW ZONE) IN RANAELVA
CONSERVATION ZONES AT REINFORSEN AND KOBBFORSEN ARE MARKED WITH RED SIGNS AND FISHING IN
THESE AREAS ARE PROHIBITED**

Fishing period:

Salmon: June 25 – August 31

Conservation periods during the fishing period are 00:00 – 06:00 at night and 12:00 – 18:00 at daytime

NB!! The opening date has no conservations restrictions.

Permitted bait:

Biggest singlehook on fly is # 6

Biggest singlehook on lure is # 1/0

Lure and fly with deactivated barbs (squeezed close to the shank) are allowed. Fly with weight ore lure as weight is not allowed

Quotas:

There are no quota on salmon over 92 cm (storlaks) These are wrong migrated salmons and are to be killed.

Exception is if the salmon has a cut marking in the dorsal fin. These are specially cultivated salmons (Ranalaks) and are to be released.

Harvested salmon over 92 cm is to be documented with picture and measure, or presented to the supervision for acceptance.

The length of the salmon is from the tip of the head to the tip of the tail

All catch (landed or released) has to be reported consecutively throughout the season and shell samples and otholits have to be taken.

All salmon under 92 cm and all sea trout are to be released.

Farmed salmon is to be killed and belongs to the fisherman after having been presented to the supervision

All char is to be killed

When two salmons have been caught and released, the fishing must cease and not resume until the next fishing day.

Every fisher who has caught and released 15 salmons must stop fishing for the rest of the season

Fish which is to be released shall not be taken out of the water. It has to be measured and released in the water.

Violation of this rule will lead to exclusion from the area for the rest of the season.

A measuring mark on the fishing rod is a requirement. This facilitates the measurement

The Fishing day changes at midnight 00:00

The week changes at midnight between Sunday and Monday at 00:00

Missing reporting with or without catch is a violation of the fishing rules, and restricts the offender from purchasing a new fishing license.
